OF

GOKALDAS EXPORTS LIMITED

1. Gokaldas Exports Limited is established with Limited by Shares in accordance with and subject to the provisions of the Companies Act, 1956, the regulations contained in Table "F" in Schedule I to the Companies Act, 2013, ("Table 'F'") as are applicable to the Company so far they are not inconsistent with any of the provisions contained in these Articles or modifications thereof and only to the extent that there is no specific provision in the Articles. In case any conflict between the provisions of these Articles and Table "F", the provisions of these Articles shall prevail.

Table "F" to apply save as varied

The Regulations for management of the Company and for the observance of the members shall be such as are contained in these Articles.

In the interpretation of these Articles, unless repugnant to the subject of context:-

Interpretation Clause

- a) "Act" means the Companies Act, 2013 and rules made thereunder or any statutory modification or re-enactment thereof for the time being in force and the term shall be deemed to refer to the applicable section thereof which is relatable to the relevant Article in which the said term appears in these Articles and any previous Company law, so as may be applicable
- b) "Affiliates" in relation to any Person means (i) in the case of a natural person, the Relatives of such person, and any Person Controlled by such person or the Relatives of such person, and (ii) in the case of a Person other than a natural person, any Person, which, Controls, is Controlled by, or is under Common Control with such Person:
- c) "Articles" means these Articles of association of the Company or as altered from time to time

New Articles of Association adopted by the Shareholders by passing Special Resolution by way of Postal Ballot on 28th October, 2017.

d) "Board" or "Board of Director" means a meeting of the Directors duly called and constituted, or the case may be, the Directors assembled at a meeting of the Board or the requisite number of Directors entitled to pass a circular resolution in accordance with the Articles, or the Directors of the Company collectively.

e) "Company" means Gokaldas Exports Limited

"Controlling", "Controlled by" or "Control" means, with respect to any Person, (i) the ownership of more than fifty per cent (50%) of the equity shares or other voting securities of such entity on a Fully Diluted Basis; or (ii) the possession of the power to direct the management and policies of such entity; or (iii) the power to appoint a majority of the directors, managers, partners or other individuals exercising similar authority with respect to such Person by virtue of ownership of voting securities or management or contract or in any other manner, in each case whether (a) formal or informal; (b) having legal or equitable force or not; (c) whether based on legal or equitable rights; or (d) directly or indirectly, including through one or more other entities; and the term "Common Control" shall be construed accordingly;

g) "Directors" means the Directors for the time being of the Company or as the case may be, the Directors assembled

at a meeting of Board

h) "Depository" shall mean a Depositary as defined in Section 2 of the Depositories Act, 1996

i) "Fully Diluted Basis" means, in reference to any calculation, that the calculation should be made in relation to the equity share capital of any Person, assuming that all outstanding convertible preference shares or debentures, options, warrants and other equity securities convertible into or exercisable or exchangeable for equity shares of that Person (whether or not by their terms then currently convertible, exercisable or exchangeable), have been so converted, exercised or exchanged to the maximum number of equity shares possible under the terms thereof;

i) "GEX" shall mean Gokaldas Exports Limited a Company Incorporated under the Laws of India and whose present registered office is at 16/2, Residency Road, Bengaluru – 560 025 or such other place as the Company may locate its

registered office.

k) "Investor" means Clear Wealth Consultancy Services LLP, a Company incorporated under the laws of India and whose present registered office is situated at No. 305, Enterprise



Centre, Nehru Road, Vile parle (East) Mumbai - 400099.

 "Rules "means the applicable rules for the time being in force as prescribed under the relevant Sections of the Act

m) "Seal" means the Common Seal of the Company.

The marginal notes used in these Articles shall not affect the construction thereof.

Words importing the singular number shall include the plural number and words importing the masculine gender shall, where the context admits, include the feminine and neuter gender.

Unless the context otherwise, requires, words or expressions contained in these Articles shall bear the same meaning as in the Act or any statutory modification thereof in force at the date which these Articles become binding on the Company.

Share Capital and variation of rights

3. The Authorized Share capital of the Company shall be as stated in Clause V of the Memorandum of Association, with the power to increase or reduce such capital from time to time in accordance with the Articles and the legislative provisions for the time being in force in this behalf and with the power also to divide the share capital and to attach thereto respectively any preferential, qualified or special rights, privileges, or conditions, in accordance with the provisions of the Act and these Articles.

Shares under the control of Board

4. Subject to the provisions of the Act and these Articles, the shares in the capital of the Company shall be under the control of the Directors who may issue, allot or otherwise dispose of the same or any of them to such persons, in such proportion and on such terms and conditions and either at a Premium or at Par and at such time as they may from time to time think fit.

Shares for consideration other than cash

5. Subject to the provisions of the Act and these Articles, the Board may issue and allot shares in the Capital of the Company on payment or part payment for any property or assets of any kind whatsoever sold or transferred, goods or machinery supplied or for services rendered to the Company in the conduct of its business and any shares which may be so allotted may be issued fully paid-up or partly paid-up otherwise than for cash and if so issued, shall be deemed to be fully paid-up or partly paid-up shares, as the case may be, if the price of such shares is determined by the valuation report of registered valuer and such issuance and allotment is approved by a special resolution of the shareholders of the Company.





6. The Company may issue the following kinds of shares in accordance with these Articles, the Act, the Rules and other Applicable laws:-

Kinds of share capital

- i. Equity Share Capital:
 - a. With voting rights and / or
 - With differential voting rights as to dividend, voting or otherwise in accordance with the Rules and
- ii. Preference Share Capital
- i. Every person whose name is entered as a member in the register of members shall be entitled to receive within two months after allotment or within one month from the date of receipt by the Company of the application for the registration of transfer or transmission within such other period as the conditions of issue provide:

 One certificate for all his shares without payment of any charges: or

b. Several certificates, each for one or more of his shares, upon payment of twenty rupees or such other fees as may be fixed by the Board for each certificate after the first.

ii. Every certificate shall be under the seal and shall specify the shares to which it relates and the amount paid-up there-on.

- iii. In respect of any share or shares held by jointly by several persons, the company shall not be bound to issue more than one certificate and delivery of certificate for a share to one of several joint holders shall be sufficient delivery to all such shareholders.
- i. If any share certificate be worn out, defaced, mutilated or torn or if there be no further space on the back of endorsement of transfer, then upon production and surrender thereof to the Company, a new certificate may be issued in lieu thereof, and if any certificate is lost or destroyed then upon proof thereof to the satisfaction of the Company and on execution of such indemnity as the Company may deem adequate, a new certificate, in lieu thereof shall be given. Every certificate under this Article shall be issued without any fee or payment of such other fees as may be fixed by the Board from time to time in accordance with the Act, for each certificate.
- ii. The provisions of the foregoing Articles relating to issue of certificates shall *mutatis mutandis* apply to issue of certificates for any other securities including debentures (except where the Act otherwise requires) of the Company.

- 9. Except as required by law, no person shall be recognized by the Company as holding any share upon trust, and the Company shall not be bound by or be compelled in any way to recognize (even when having notice thereof) any equitable, contingent, future or partial interest in any share, or any interest in any fractional part of share, or (except only as by the Articles or by law otherwise provided) any other rights in respect of any share except an absolute right to the entirety thereof in the registered holder.
- i. The Company may exercise the powers of paying commissions conferred by the Act, to any person in connection with the subscription to its securities provided that the rate percent or the amount of the commission paid or agreed to be paid shall be disclosed in the manner required by the Act and the Rules.

Power to pay commission in connection with securities issued

- ii. The rate or amount if the commission shall not exceed the rate or amount prescribed in the Act and the Rules.
- iii. The commission may be satisfied by the payment of cash or the allotment of fully or partly paid shares or partly in the one way and partly in the other.
- i. If at any time the share capital is divided into different class of shares, the rights attached to any class (unless otherwise provided by the terms of issue of the shares of that class) may be subject to the provisions of the Act, and whether or not the Company is being wound up, be varied with the consent in writing of the holders of three fourths of the issued shares of that class or with the sanction of a special resolution passed at a separate meeting of the holders of the shares of that class prescribed under the Act.

Variation of the members rights

- ii. To every such separate meeting, the provisions of these regulations relating to general meetings shall *mutatis mutandis* apply, but so that the necessary quorum shall be at least two persons holding at least one third of the issued shares of the class in question.
- 12. The rights conferred upon the holders of the shares of any class issued with preferred or other rights shall not, unless otherwise expressly provided by the terms of issue of the shares of that class, be deemed to be varied by the creation or issue of further shares ranking pari passu therewith.

Issue of further shares not affecting rights of existing members

Subject to the provisions of the Act, any preference shares may, with the sanction of a special resolution, be issued or re-issued on the terms that they are to be redeemed on such terms and in such manner as the Company before the issue of the shares may by such special resolution, determine.

Power to issue redeemable preference shares

14. The Company, as the case may be, in accordance with the Act Further issue of and the Rules, issue further shares to:

share capital

- a. Persons who, at the date of offer, are holders of equity shares of the Company; such offer shall be deemed to include a right exercisable by the person concerned or renounce the shares offered to him or any of them in favour of any other person; or
- b. Employees under the scheme of employees stock option, subject to approval by the shareholders of the Company by way of a special resolution; or
- c. Any persons, whether or not those persons include the persons referred to in clause (a) of clause (b) above, subject to approval by the shareholders of the Company by way of a special resolution.
- A further issue of shares may be made in any manner whatsoever as the Board may determine including by way of preferential offer or private placement, subject to and in accordance with the Act and the Rules.
- 15. Any debentures, debenture stock or other securities may be issued subject to the provisions of the Act and these Articles, at a discount, premium or otherwise and may be issued on the condition that they shall be convertible into shares of any denomination and with any special privileges and conditions as to redemption, surrender, drawing, allotment of shares, attending (but not voting) at the general meeting, appointment of directors and otherwise, Debentures or other securities with the right to conversion into or allotment of shares shall be issued only with the consent of the Company in the general meeting by way of special resolution.

Terms of issue of debentures

The Company shall have first and paramount lien -

a. On every share (not being a fully paid-share), for all monies (whether presently payable or not) called, or payable at a fixed time in respect of that share; and

- b. On all shares (not being fully paid-shares) standing registered in the name of a single person, for all monies presently payable by him or his estate to the Company; Provided that the Board may at time declare any share to be wholly or in part exempt from the provisions of this
- ii. The Company's lien, if any, on a share shall extend to all dividends or interest, as the case may be, payable and bonuses declared from time to time in respect of such shares.

Company's lien on shares





17. The Company may sell, in such manner as the Board thinks fit, any shares on which the Company has a lien;

As to enforcing lien by sale

Provided that no sale shall be made:

- Unless a sum in respect of which the lien exists is presently payable; or
- b. Until the expiration of fourteen days after notice in writing stating and demanding payment of such part of the amount in respect of which the lien exists as is presently, payable, has been given to the registered holder for the time being of the share or the person entitled thereto by reason of his death or insolvency or otherwise.
- 18. i. To give effect to any such sale, the Board may authorize one person to transfer the shares sold to the purchaser thereof

ii. The Purchaser shall be registered as the holder of the shares comprised in any such transfer

iii. The purchaser shall not be bound to see to the application of purchase money, nor shall his title to the shares affected by irregularity or invalidity in the proceedings in reference to the sale.

Validity of sale

19. The receipt of the Company for a consideration (if any) given for the share on the sale thereof shall (subject, if necessary, to execution of an instrument of transfer by relevant system, as the case may be) constitute a good title to the share and the purchaser shall be registered as the holder of the share.

Validity of company's receipt

 i. The proceeds of the sale shall be received by the Company and applied in payment of such part of the amount in respect of which the lien exists as is presently payable.

ii. The residue, if any, shall, subject to a like for sums not presently payable as existed upon the shares before the sale, be paid to the person entitled to the shares at the date of sale.

Application of proceeds of sale

21. In exercise of lien, the Company shall be entitled to treat the registered holder of any share as the absolute owner thereof and accordingly shall not (except as ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction or unless required by any statute) be bound to recognize any equitable or other claim to, or interest in, such share on the part of any other person, whether creditor of registered holder or otherwise. The Company's lien shall prevail notwithstanding that it has receive notice of any such claim.

Outsider's lien shall not to effect company's lien





22. The Provisions of these Articles relating to lien shall *mutatis mutandis* apply to any other securities including debentures of the Company.

Provisions as to lien to apply mutatis mutandis to debentures etc.,

Certificates

Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in these Articles, the Board may in their absolute discretion refuse sub-division of share certificates or debenture certificates into denominations of less than marketable lots except where such sub-division is required to be made to comply with a statutory provision of an order of a competent court of law.

Right of Directors to refuse subdivision

Notwithstanding anything contained elsewhere in these Articles, a certificate, if required, for a dematerialized share, debenture, and other security shall be issued in the name of the depository and all the provisions contained in these Articles in respect of rights of a member / debenture holder of the Company shall mutatis mutandis apply to the Depository as if it were a member or debenture holder / security holder excepting that and notwithstanding that the depository shall have been registered as the holder of a dematerialized share, debenture and other security, the person who is the beneficial owner of such shares, debentures and other securities shall be entitled to all other rights available to the registered holders of shares, debentures and other securities in the Company as set out in the other provisions of these Articles.

Issue of certificates, if required, in the case of dematerialiazed shares / debentures / other securities

Dematerialization of Securities

25. Notwithstanding anything contained in these Articles, the Company shall be entitled to dematerialize its shares and other securities and to offer any shares, debentures, or other securities proposed to be issued by it for subscription in a dematerialized form and on the same being done, the Company shall further entitled to maintain a register of members / debenture holders/ other security holders with the details of members / debenture holders/ other security holders holding shares, debentures or other securities both in materialized and dematerialized form in any media as permitted by the Act.

Company entitled to dematerialize its shares debentures

Every person subscribing to or holding securities of the Company shall have the option to receive security certificates or to hold the securities in electronic form with a depository. If a person opts to hold his security with a depository, the Company shall intimate such depository the details of allotment of the security and on receipt of information, the Depository

shall enter in its records the name of the allottee as the beneficial owner of the security.

27. Save as herein otherwise provided, the Company shall be entitled to treat the person whose name appears as the beneficial owner of the shares, debenture and other securities in the records of the Depository as the absolute owner thereof as regards receipt of dividends or bonus on shares, interest / premium on debentures and other securities and repayment thereof or for service of notices and all or any other matters connected with the Company and accordingly the Company shall not (except as ordered by a court of competent jurisdiction or as by law required and except as aforesaid) be bound to recognize any benami trust or equity or equitable, contingent or other claim to or interest in such shares, debentures or other securities as the case may be, on the part of any other person whether or not it shall have express or implied notice thereof.

Beneficial owner deemed absolute owner

28. In the case of transfer of shares, debentures or other securities where the Company has not issued any certificates and where such shares, debentures or other securities are being held in an electronic and fungible form, the provisions of the Depositories Act, 1996 shall apply.

Shares, debentures and other securities held in electronic form

Provided that in respect of the shares and securities held by the Depository on behalf of a beneficial owner, provisions of Section 9 of the Depositories Act, 1996, shall apply so far as applicable.

Information about transfer of securities

29. Every depository shall furnish to the Company, information about the transfer of securities in the name of the beneficial owner at such intervals and in such manner as may be specified by the bye-laws of the Depository and the Company in that behalf.

Provisions to apply to shares in electronic form

30. Except as specifically provided in these Articles, the provisions relating to joint holders of shares, calls, lien on shares, forfeiture of shares and transfer and transmission of shares shall be applicable to shares held in electronic form so far as they apply to shares in physical form subject to however to the provisions of the Depositories Act, 1996.

Calls on shares

 The Board may from time to time, make calls upon the members in respect of any monies unpaid on their shares (whether on account of the nominal value of the shares or by way of premium) and not by the conditions of allotment thereof made payable at fixed times;

Provided that no call shall exceed one fourth of the nominal value of the share or be payable at less than one month from the date fixed for payment of the last preceding call.

ii. Each member shall subject to receiving at least fourteen days

notice specifying the time or times and place of payment, pay to the Company, at the time or times and place so specified, the amount called on his shares.

- iii. The Board may from time to time, at its discretion, extend the time fixed for the payment of any call in respect of one or more members as the Board may deem appropriate in any circumstances.
- iv. A call may be revoked or postponed at the discretion of the Board.
- A call shall be deemed to have been made at the time when the resolution of the Board authorizing the call was passed and may be required to be paid by installments.

Call to take effect from the date of resolution

The joint holders of share shall be jointly and severally liable to pay all calls in respect thereof.

Liability of joint holders of shares

i. If a sum called in respect of share is not paid before or on the day appointed for payment thereof, the person from whom the sum is due shall pay interest thereon from the day appointed for payment thereof to the time of actual payment at ten percent per annum or at such lower rate, if any, as the Board may determine.

When interest on call payable

Effect of non -

payment of sums

- ii. The Board shall be at liberty to waive payment of any such interest wholly or in part.
- i. Any sum which by the terms of issue of a share becomes payable on allotment of at any fixed date, where on account of the nominal value of the share or by way of premium, shall, for the purposes of these Articles, be deemed to be a call duly made and payable on the date on which by the terms of issue such sum becomes payable.

ii. In case of non payment of such sum, all the relevant provisions of these Articles as to payment of interest and expenses, forfeiture or otherwise shall apply as if such sum had become payable by virtue of call duly made and notified.

36. The Board:

- i. may, if it thinks fit, receive from any member willing to advance the same all or any part of the monies uncalled and un-paid upon any shares held by him
- ii. upon all or any of the monies so advanced, may (until the same would but for such advance become presently payable) pay interest at such rate not exceeding, unless the Company in general meeting shall otherwise direct, twelve percent per annum as may be agreed upon between the Board and the member paying the sum in advance. Nothing contained in this

clause shall confer on the member(a) any right to participate in profits or dividends or (b) any voting rights in respect of the moneys so paid by him until the same would but for such payment become presently payable by him.

37. If by the conditions of allotment of any shares, the whole or part of the amount of issue price thereof shall be payable by installments then every such installment shall when due, be paid to the Company by the person who, for the time being and from time to time, is or shall be registered holder of the share or the legal representative of a deceased registered holder.

Installments on shares to be duly paid

38. All calls shall be made on uniform basis on all shares falling under the same class.

Calls on shares of the same class to be on uniform basis

Neither a judgment nor a decree in favour of the Company for calls or other moneys due in respect of any shares nor any part of payment of satisfaction thereof no the receipt by the Company of a portion of any money which shall from time to time be due from any member in respect of payment of any such money shall preclude the forfeiture of such shares as herein provided.

Partial payment not to preclude forfeiture

40. The provisions of these Articles relating to calls on shares shall *mutatis mutandis* apply to any other securities including debentures of the Company.

Provisions as to calls to apply mutatis mutandis debentures etc.

Transfer of shares

i. The Instrument of transfer of any share in the Company which is in physical form shall be executed by or on behalf of both the transferor and transferee.

Instrument of transfer to be executed by transferor and transferee

ii. The transferor shall be deemed to remain in a holder of the share until the name of the transferee is entered in the register of members in respect thereof.

Transfer not to be registered except on production of instrument of transfer

42. The Company shall not transfer of shares in or debentures of the Company held in physical form unless proper instrument of transfer duly stamped and executed by or on behalf of the transferor and by or on behalf of the transferee and specifying the name, address and occupation, if any, of the transferee has been delivered to the Company along with the certificates relating to the shares or debentures or if no such certificate is in existence along with the letter of allotment of shares or debentures.

Provided that where on an application in writing made to the Company by the transferee and bearing the stamp required for an instrument of





transfer, it is proved to the satisfaction of the Board that the instrument of transfer singed by or on behalf of the transferor and by or on behalf of the transferee has been lost or where the instrument of transfer has not been delivered within the prescribed period, the Company may register the transfer on such terms as to indemnity as the Board may think fit.

Provided further that nothing in this Article shall prejudice any power of the Company to register as shareholder or debenture holder any person to whom the right to any shares in or debentures of, the Company has been transmitted by operation of law.

43. In case of shares held in physical form, the Board may, subject to the right of appeal conferred by the Act decline to register any transfer of shares on which Company has a lien.

Board may refuse to register transfer

44. A transfer of the shares or other interest in the Company of a deceased member thereof made by his legal representatives shall, although the legal representative is not himself a member be as valid as if he had been a member at the time of the execution of the instrument of transfer.

Transfer by legal representative

Where the application is made by the transferor and relates to partly paid shares the transfer shall not be registered, unless the Company gives notice of the application to the transferee and the transferee makes no objection to the transfer within two weeks from the date of receipt of the notice.

Transfer of partly paid shares

For the purpose of above, clause notice to the transferee shall be deemed to have been duly given if it is dispatched by pre-paid registered post to the transferee at the address given in the instrument of transfer and shall be deemed to have been duly delivered upon the expiry of seven days from the date of dispatch.

- In case of shares held in physical form, the Board may decline to register any instrument unless:
 - The instrument of transfer is in the form as prescribed in the Rules or under the Act;
 - The instrument of transfer is accompanied by the Certificate of the shares to which it relates and such other evidence as the Board may reasonably require to show the right of the transferor to make the transfer; and
 - iii. The instrument of transfer is in respect of only one class of shares.

47. If the Company refuses to register the transfer of any share pursuant to these Articles, it shall within thirty days from the date on which the instrument of transfer was delivered to the Company send notice of

48. No transfer shall be made to a person of unsound mind. However, transfer of fully paid-up shares can be made in the name of minor if he is represented by his lawful guardian.

No transfer to minor

49. All instruments of transfer shall be retained by the Company, but any instrument of transfer which the Board may decline to register shall be returned to the person depositing the same.

When transfers to be retained

50. The Board may, in their discretion, waive the payment of any transfer or transmission fee either generally or in any particular case or cases.

Fee on transfer

51. The Company may after, giving not less than seven days previous notice by advertisement in some newspaper circulating in the district in which the registered office is situate, close the register of members or the registered debenture holders or other security holders for any period or periods not exceeds in the whole forty five days in each year, but not exceeding thirty days at any one time.

Power to close register of members or other security holders

52. The provisions of these Articles relating to transfer of shares shall mutatis mutandis apply to any other securities including debentures of the Company.

Provisions as to transfer of shares to apply mutatis mutandis to debentures etc..

Transmission of shares

 i. On the death of a member, the survivor or survivors where the member was a joint holder and his nominee or nominees or legal representatives where he was a sole holder shall be the only persons recognized by the Company having any title to his interest in the shares.

Estate of deceased member liable

ii. Nothing in clause (i) shall release estate of a deceased joint holder from any liability in respect of any share which had been duly held by him with other persons.

Transmission

- i. Any person becoming entitled to share in consequence of the death or insolvency of a member may upon such evidence being produced as may from time to time properly be required by the Board and subject as hereinafter provided, elect, either –
 - a. To be registered himself as holder of the share ; or
 - To make such transfer of the share as the deceased or insolvent member could have made
 - ii. The Board shall, in either case, have the same right to decline or suspend registration as it would have had, if the deceased or insolvent member had transferred the share before his death or insolvency.

55. The Company shall be fully indemnified by such person from all liability if any by actions taken by the Board to give effect to such registration or transfer.

Indemnity to the Company

56.

 If a person so becoming entitled shall elect to be registered as holder of the share himself, he shall deliver or send to the Company a notice in writing signed by him stating that he so elects. Right to election of holder of share

- ii. If the person aforesaid elect to transfer the share, he shall testify his election by executing a transfer of the share
- iii. All the limitations, restrictions and provisions of these Articles relating to the right to transfer and the registration of transfer of shares shall be applicable to any such notice or transfer as aforesaid as if the death or insolvency of the member had not occurred and the notice of transfer were a transfer signed by that member.

A person becoming entitled to a share by reason of the death or insolvency of the holder shall be entitled to the same dividends and other advantages to which he would be entitled if he were the registered holder of the share, except that he shall not before being registered as a member in respect of the share, be entitled in respect of it to exercise any right conferred by membership in relating to meetings of the Company.

Claimant to be entitled to same advantage

Provided that the Board may, at any time, give notice requiring any such person to elect either to be registered himself or to transfer the share, and if the notice is not complied with within ninety days, the Board may thereafter withhold payment of all dividends, bonuses, or other monies payable in respect of the share, until the requirements of the notice have been complied with.

The provisions of these Articles relating to transmission by operation of law shall mutatis mutandis apply to any other securities including debentures of the Company.

Provisions as to transmission of shares to apply mutatis mutandis to debentures etc.,

Forfeiture of Shares

59. If a members fails to pay any call or installment of a call, on the day appointed for payment thereof, the Board may, at any time thereafter during such time as any part of the call or installment remains unpaid, serve a notice on him requiring payment of so much of the call or installment as is un-paid, together with any interest which may have accrued.

Forfeiture shares may be sold

A person whose shares have been forfeited shall cease to be a member in respect of the forfeited shares, but shall, notwithstanding the forfeiture, remain liable to pay to the Company all monies which at the date of forfeiture were presently payable by him to the Company in respect of the shares.

Member still liable to pay money owing at time of forfeiture

- ii. All such monies payable shall be paid together with interest thereon at such rate as the Board may determine, from time to time of forfeiture until payment or realization. The Board may, if it thinks fit, but without being under any obligation to do so, enforce the payment of the whole or any portion of the monies due, without any allowance for the value of the shares at the time of forfeiture or waive payment in whole or in part.

Joint Holders

76. Where two or more persons are registered as joint holders (not more than three) of any share they shall be deemed (so far as the Company is concerned) to hold the same as joint holders with benefits of survivor ship, subject to the following and other provisions contained in these Articles:

Joint holders

- i. The joint holders of any share shall be liable severally as well as jointly for and in respect of all calls or installments and other payments which out to be made in respect of such share.
- ii. On the death of any one or more such joint holders, the survivor or survivors shall be the only person or persons recognized by the Company as having any title to the share but the Directors may require such evidence of death as they deem fit and nothing herein contained shall be taken to release the estate of deceased joint holder from any liability on shares held by him jointly with any other person.
- iii. Any one of such joint holders may give effectual receipts of any dividends, interests or other moneys payable in respect of such share
- iv. Only the person whose name stands first in the register of members as one of joint holders of any share shall be entitled to the delivery of certificate if any relating to such share or to receive notice (which term shall be deemed to include all relevant documents) and any notice served on or sent to such person shall be deemed service on all joint holders.
 - a. Any one of two or more joint holders may vote at any meeting either personally or by attorney or by proxy in respect of such shares as if he were solely entitled thereto and if more than one of such joint holders be present at any meeting personally or by proxy or by attorney then that one such persons so present whose name stands first or higher (as the case may be) on the register in respect of such shares shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof but the other or others of joint holders shall be entitled to vote in preference to a joint holder present by attorney or by proxy although the name of such joint holder present by any attorney or proxy stands first or higher (as the case may be) in the register in respect of such shares.
 - b. Several executors or administrators of a deceased member in whose (deceased member) sole name any share stands, shall for the purpose of this clause be deemed to joint-holders.

Capitalization of Profits

- 77. i. The Company in general meeting may, upon the **Sum how applied** recommendation of the Board resolve
 - a. That it is desirable to capitalize any part of the amount for the time being standing to the credit of any of the Company's reserve accounts or to the credit of the profit and loss statement or otherwise available for distribution
 - b. That such sum be accordingly set free for distribution in the manner specified in the clause (ii) amongst the members who would have been entitled thereto, if distributed by way of dividend and in the same proportions.
 - ii. The sum aforesaid shall not be paid in cash but shall be applied subject to the provision contained in clause (iii) either in or towards –
 - Paying up any amounts for the time being un-paid on any shares held by such members respectively;
 - Paying up in full, unissued shares of the Company to be allotted and distributed, credited as fully paid-up to and amongst such members in the proportions aforesaid;
 - c. Partly in the way specified in sub-clause (a) and partly in that specified in sub-clause (b)
 - d. A securities premium account and a capital redemption reserve account may , for the purposes of this regulation, be applied in the paying up of un issued shares to be issued to members of the Company as fully paid-up bonus shares:
 - e. The Board shall give effect to the resolution passed by the Company in pursuance of this Article.

Restrictions on purchase of by Company of its own shares

General Meetings

81. The Company shall in each year hold a General Meeting as its Annual General Meeting in addition to any other meetings in that year. An Annual General Meeting of the Company shall be held within six months after the expiry of each financial year, provided that not more than fifteen months shall lapse between the date of one Annual General Meeting and that of the next. Provided that it will be permissible to hold its first Annual General Meeting within a period of not less than Nine months from the date of its incorporation; and if such meeting is held within that period it shall not be necessary for the Company to hold any Annual General Meeting in the year of its incorporation or in the following calendar year. Nothing contained in the foregoing provisions shall be taken as affecting the right conferred upon the Registrar under the provisions of the Act to extend the time within which any Annual General Meeting may be held.

- All general meetings other than annual general meeting shall be called extraordinary general meeting.

Extra ordinary general meeting

The Board may, whenever it thinks fit, call an extraordinary general meeting and it shall do so upon a requisition in writing by any Member or Members holding in the aggregate not less than one- tenth of such of the paid-up capital as at that date carries the right of voting in regard to the matter in respect of which the requisition has been made;

Subject to the provisions of the Act, the Board shall have power at any time, and from time to time, to appoint a person as an additional director, provided the number of Directors and additional directors together shall not at any time exceed the maximum strength fixed for the Board by the Articles.

i. Such person shall hold office only up to the date of the next annual general meeting of the Company but shall be eligible for appointment by the Company as a Director at that meeting subject to the provisions of the Act.

Appointment of Additional director

119. The Board may appoint an alternate director to act for a Director (hereinafter in these Articles during his absence for a period of not less than three months from India. No person shall be appointed as an alternate director for an independent director unless he is qualified to be appointed as an independent director under the provisions of the Act The Investor shall be entitled through the Investor Directors to nominate an alternate Director to act in accordance with the Act for any Director nominated by the Investor and shall issue a written notice to the Company providing the name and contact address of such alternate Director ("Alternate Director Nomination Notice").

Appointment of alternate director

The investor shall also have a right to withdraw their nominated alternate Director and nominate another in his place.



Banga Banga

120. An alternate director shall not hold office for a period longer than that permissible to the Original Director in whose place he has been appointed and shall vacate the office if and when the Original Director returns to India.

Duration of office of alternate director

The Company shall have the right to recommend such number as required by the Act, or such rules and regulations of SEBI or Stock exchanges where the shares of the company is listed Individual Persons for appointment to the Board as Independent Directors subject to the written acceptance of the Investor in respect of each of such Independent Directors. Provided that if the Independent Directors are not acceptable to the Investor, the Investor shall have the sole discretion to identify such Individual Persons to be appointed Independent Directors.

Appointment of Independent Director

The Board may, from time to time, constitute committees of the Board 122. (consisting exclusively of Directors) and may determine their functions, powers, authorities and responsibilities, subject to applicable law, each committee of the Board so constituted shall however, include at least one (1) Investor Director. The presence of such Investor Director shall be required for the purpose of constituting quorum for any meeting of such committees. If such a quorum is not present within one hour from the time appointed for the meeting, the meeting shall adjourn to such place and time as those committee members who did attend shall decide or, if no such decision is reached, at the same place and time seven Business Days later, at which meeting("Adjourned Committee Meeting") the Directors present shall constitute a valid quorum even if the Investor Director is not present, provided that written notice of such Adjourned Committee Meeting shall have been delivered to all committee members at least five (5) Business Days prior to the date of such Adjourned Committee Meeting.

Committees

The Investor shall have the right to require the removal of an Investor Director, at any time and shall be entitled to nominate another representative as a Director in place of the Director so removed. In the event of the resignation or retirement of an Investor Director, the Investor, shall be entitled to nominate another representative as Director in place of such Investor Director. Such successor or replacement Investor Director shall be nominated and elected on or as soon as practicable after the date of such resignation or removal and in any event within twenty-one (21) Business Days after such resignation or removal.

Removal and replacement of Directors.

124. Permanent Directors: Two (2) Investor Directors, shall be appointed as permanent members of the Board and shall not be liable to retirement by rotation.

Permanent Directors

125. Chairman/Vice Chairman: Investor shall have the right to appoint the chairman of the Company from amongst the Investor Directors. The Chairman shall have a casting or second vote.

126.Key Officers: Any appointment of the Chief Executive Officer, Chief Financial Officers and Chief Operating Officer ("Key Officer") shall be with the connivance/consent of the Investor represented through the Investor Director who is designated as the permanent Director. All appointments of Key Officers shall be done on the basis of "Best available person for the job" principle. The Company shall ensure that the Key Officers of the Company execute reasonably satisfactory employment/engagements letters in accordance with industry standards.

Officers and Managers

127. Director's access: Directors shall be entitled to examine the books, accounts and records of the Company and shall have free access, at all reasonable times and with prior reasonable written notice, to any and all properties and facilities of the Company. The Company shall provide such information relating to the business affairs and financial position of the Company, as the Directors may reasonable require. Such information shall be as mutually agreed on a good faith basis by the Chief Financial Officer of the Company along with the Investor. The Directors may provide such information to the Party by whom they have been nominated.

Director Access

128. If the term of office of the Original Director is determined before he returns to India the automatic reappointment of retiring Directors in default of another appointment shall apply to the Original Director and not to the alternate director. Re-appointment provisions applicable to Original Director

129.

- i. If the office of any Director appointed by the Company in general meeting is vacated before his term of office expires in the normal course, the resulting casual vacancy may, be filled by the Board of Directors at a meeting of the Board.
- ii. The Director so appointed shall hold office only upto the date upto which the Director in whose he is appointed would have held office if it had not been vacated.

Appointment of director to fill casual vacancies

Power of Board

The management of the business of the Company shall be vested in the Board and the Board may exercise all such powers, and do all such acts and things, as the Company is by the memorandum of association or otherwise authorized to exercise and do, and, not hereby or by the statue or otherwise directed or required to be exercised or done by the Company in general meeting but subject nevertheless to the provisions of the Act and other laws and of the memorandum of association and these Articles and to any regulations, not being inconsistent with the memorandum of association and these Articles or the Act, from time to time made by the Company in general meeting provided that no such regulation shall invalidate any prior act of the Board which would have been valid if such regulation had not been made.

General powers of the Company vested in Board





Borrowing Powers

131. The Directors may, from time to time, at their discretion, raise or borrow, or secure the payment of, any sum or sums of money for the purposes of the Company; Provided that the moneys to be borrowed together with the moneys already borrowed by the Company (apart from temporary loans obtained from the Company's bankers in the ordinary course of business) shall not at any time except with the consent of the Company by way of special resolution in general meeting exceed the aggregate of the paid –up capital of the Company and its free reserves, that is to say, reserves not set apart for any specific purpose.

Power to borrow

The Directors, with shareholders' consent where required by the Act and Rules, may raise or secure the payment or repayment of such sum or sums in such manner and upon such terms and conditions in all respects as they think fit and, in particular, by the issue of debentures or debenture –stock of the Company charged upon all or any part of the property of the Company (both present and future) including its uncalled capital for the time being.

Conditions on which money may be borrowed

Proceedings of the Board

i. The Board of Directors may meet for the conduct of business, adjourn and otherwise regulate its meetings, as it thinks fit.

When meeting to be convened

- ii. The Chairperson or any one Director with the previous consent of the Chairperson may, or the company secretary on the direction of the Chairperson shall, at any time summon a meeting of the Board.
- A meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held at least four times every year and not more than 120 days shall lapse between two Board meetings.
- Notice of every meeting of the Board of Directors of the Company shall be given in writing to every Director at his address registered with the Company and such notice shall be sent by hand delivery of by post or by electronic means. Notice: A meeting of the Board may be called by the Chairman of the board or any Director giving notice in writing to the company secretary of the Company specifying the date, time and agenda for such meeting. The company Secretary shall upon receipt of such notice give a copy of such notice to all Directors shall ensure that notice of a meeting of the Board shall be accompanies by necessary background and other information and/or supporting documents pertaining to the business proposed to be transacted thereat. Not less than seven (7) Business days notice of a meeting of the Board shall be given to all Directors; provided, however, that such notice period may be reduced with the written consent of a majority of the Directors, provided, however, that such majority shall include an Investor Director.

Notice of Meetings

135. The quorum for a Board Meeting shall be as provided in the Act. Quorum: Subject to the provisions of the Act, all meetings of the Board shall require a quorum of at least two Directors; provided, however, that the quorum must include at least one investor Director in respect of any meeting of the Board. such a quorum is not present within one hour from the time appointed for the meeting, the meeting shall adjourn to such place and time as those Directors who did attend shall decide or, if no such decision is reached, at the same place and time Seven Business Days later, at which meeting ("Adjourned Board Meeting") the Directors present shall constitute a valid quorum even though the Investor Director is not present, provided that written notice of such Adjourned Board Meeting shall have been delivered to all Directors at least five (5) Business Days prior to the date of such Adjourned Board Meeting.

138. In case of an equality of votes, the Chairperson of the Board shall have a second or casting vote.

Casting vote of Chairperson at Board meeting

139. The continuing Directors may act notwithstanding any vacancy in the Board; but, if and so long as their number is reduced below the quorum fixed by the Act for a meeting of the Board, the continuing Directors or Director may act for the purpose of increasing the number of Directors to that fixed for the quorum, or of summoning a general meeting of the Company, but for no other purpose.

Directors not to act when number falls below minimum

 i. The Board may elect a Chairperson of its meetings and determine the period for which he is to hold office.

Who to preside at meetings of the Board

ii. if at any meeting the Chairperson, is not present within fifteen minutes after the time appointed for holding the meeting, the Directors present may choose one of their number to be Chairperson of the meeting.

The Board may, subject to the provisions of the Act, delegate any of its powers to committees consisting of such member or members of its body as it thinks fit. Delegation of powers

The registers and copies of annual return shall be open for inspection during 1.00 pm to 3.00 pm on all working days other than Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays at the registered office of the Company by the persons entitled thereto on payment, where required, of such fees as may be fixed by the Board but not exceeding the limits prescribed by the Rules.

Statutory registers

- i. The Company may exercise the powers conferred on it by the Act with regard to the keeping of a foreign register, and the Board may (subject to the provisions of the Act) make and vary such regulations as it may think fit respecting the keeping of any such register.
- ii. The foreign register shall be open for inspection and may be closed, and extracts may be taken therefrom and copies thereof may be required, in the same manner, *mutatis mutandis*, as is applicable to the register of members.

The Seal

150. The Company shall have a common seal and the Directors shall provide for the safe custody thereof. The Seal shall not be affixed to any instrument except; Seal

- ii. in the presence of the least one Director or Chief Financial Officer or Company Secretary or such other person as the Board may appoint for the purpose, who shall sign every instrument to which the Seal is so affixed. Such signatures shall be conclusive evidence of the fact that the Seal has been properly affixed.

Dividends and Reserve

151. The Company in general meeting may declare dividends, but no dividend shall exceed the amount recommended by the Board.

- 167. Subject to the provisions of Chapter XX of the Act and Rules thereunder

If the Company shall be wound up, the liquidator may, with the sanction of a special resolution of the Company and any other sanction required by the Act, divide amongst the members, in specie or kind, the whole or any part of the assets of the Company, whether they shall consist of property of the same kind or not.
 - ii. For the purpose aforesaid, the liquidator may set such value as he deems fair upon any property to be divided as aforesaid and may determine how such division shall be carried out as between the members or different classes of members.
 - iii. The tiquidator may, with the like sanction, vest the whole or any part of such assets in trustees upon such trusts for the benefit of the contributories if he considers necessary, but so that no member shall be compelled to accept any shares or other securities whereon there is any liability.

Indemnity and Insurance

Subject to the provisions of the Act, every Director, Managing Director, Whole Time Director, Manager, Chief Financial Officer, Company Secretary and other officer of the Company shall be indemnified by the Company out of the funds of the Company, to pay all costs, losses and expenses(including travelling expense) which such Director, Manager, Company Secretary and officer may incur or become liable for by reason of any contract entered into or act or deed done by him in his capacity as such Director, Manager, Company Secretary or Officer or in any way in the discharge of his duties in such capacity including expenses.

Subject as aforesaid, every Director, Managing Director, Manager, Company Secretary or other Officer of the Company shall be indemnified against any liability incurred by him in defending any proceedings, whether civil or criminal in which judgment is given in his favour or in which he is acquitted or discharged or in connection with any application under applicable provisions of the Act in which relief is given to him by a court or such authority.

170. The Company may take and maintain any insurance as the Board may think fit on behalf of its present and /or former Directors and Key Managerial Personnel for indemnifying all or any of them against any liability for any acts in relation to the Company for which they may be liable but have acted honestly and

General Power

171. Wherever in the Act or the Rules, it has been provided that the Company shall have any right, privilege or authority or that the Company could carry out any transaction only if the Company is so authorized by its articles, thane and in that case this Article authorizes and empowers the Company to have such rights, privileges or authorities and to carry such transactions as have been permitted by the Act, without there being any specific Article in that behalf herein provided.

General Power

Secrecy Clause

172. Subject to the provisions of the Act, no member shall be entitled to require Secrecy Clause discovery of any information respecting any detail of the Company's trading or any matter in the nature of a trade secret, mystery of trade or secret process which may relate to the conduct of the business of the Company and which in the opinion of the Board of Directors it may be inexpedient in the interest of the Company to communicate to the public.


